Regina Race Manager (1)

Saturday, September 24th, 2011 - 6 AM - 8:30 AM

1. Responsible for overseeing the Regina race on event day
2. Assists in setup and take-down on event day
3. Contacts an individual who acts as special guest at the event handing out awards
4. Assists in the setup of two water stations and start/finish line at Wascana lake
5. Speaker at the event - Announcements, thanking sponsors, introducing special guest for awards ceremony, etc.

Sponsorship & Donation Coordinator (1)

1. Assists the event coordinator to find and contact potential sponsors in Regina, Saskatoon, and other places
2. Contacts potential sponsors in coordination with event coordinator
3. Sends out donation emails/letters (Different from sponsorship letters as most of these donors are individuals and organizations who will receive tax receipts)
4. Assists the event coordinator in the procurement of food donations

Race Setup: Saskatoon (6), Regina (3)

Saturday, September 24th, 2011 - Saskatoon (5 AM - 8 AM), Regina (6 AM - 8 AM)

1. Assists the event coordinator/Regina race manager to setup pylons, tents, water stations, etc as required
2. Cheers participants at race start!!!

Race Take down: Saskatoon (6), Regina (3)

Saturday, September 24th, 2011 - Saskatoon (1 PM - 2 PM), Regina (11 AM - 12 PM)

1. Assists the event coordinator/Regina race manager to setup pylons, tents, water stations, etc.
2. Cheers participants as race comes to a close!!!

Water/Aid Station Supervisor: **Saskatoon (2), Regina (1)**

Saturday, September 24th, 2011 - 6 AM - 8:30 AM; 12 PM - 1 PM

1. Assists in the setup of water stations on event day such as setting up tables and water jugs
2. Assists in the take down of water stations
3. Primary contact for injuries to runners on event day and subsequent management (Do not need to provide first aid, just call 911!!)

Water Station Volunteers: **Saskatoon (20), Regina (5)**

Saturday, September 24th, 2011 - 8 AM - 1 PM

1. Setup and take down water station with help from other volunteers
2. Handing out water to runners/walkers as they pass by your station
3. Have loads of fun cheering on the runners and walkers as they pass by

Food Tent volunteers: **Saskatoon (2), Regina (1)**

Saturday, September 24th, 2011 - Saskatoon (9 AM - 11 PM), Regina (9 AM - 10 PM)

1. Hand out food to runners and race volunteers
2. Assists in the setup and take down of food tent

Registration Tent: **Saskatoon (2), Regina (2)**

Saturday, September 24th, 2011 - 7:30 AM - 9 PM

1. Hand out race packages to runners if they have not picked up before
2. Possibly, hold onto runners' belongings if possible but discourage this!!!

Race Marshalls: **Saskatoon (10), Regina (4)**

Saturday, September 24th, 2011 - Saskatoon (8 AM - 12 PM), Regina (8 AM - 10 PM)

1. Direct runners along the correct path
2. Cheer runners as they pass by you

Race Photographer: **Saskatoon (1), Regina (1)**

Saturday, September 24th, 2011 - Your choice of timing

1. Go crazy taking lots of photographs with your D-SLR or point-or-shoot camera!!
2. These will be posted on the website and used as promotion for Miles for Smiles 2012

Pace Bunny: **Saskatoon (3), Regina (1)**

Saturday, September 24th, 2011 - One or two hour requirement between race times

1. An individual who can run at an even pace and come within a few minutes of their announced time (Whom I shall envy for life!)

Entertainer: **Saskatoon (?), Regina (?)**

Miles for Smiles has never had entertainers along the course, hence I am not sure about this but am open to ideas and suggestions. I am sure that the runners and we, will absolutely appreciate it.

Cyclists: **Saskatoon (2), Regina (1, if necessary)**

Saturday, September 24th, 2011 - One or two hour requirement between race times

1. Lead biker to ensure that runners are following the correct path.
2. Last biker to ensure that the last runner has been accounted for. No runner shall be left behind!!!

Super Volunteers: **Saskatoon & Regina**

Saturday, September 24th, 2011 - One or two hours anytime

1. Volunteers who can do anything and can help on event day!
